Corian scratch susceptibility


Caring for your Corian surface

VULNERABILITY:

Corian is made from natural minerals and acrylic polymer, which makes it softer than quartz or granite. Dropping or dragging sharp, heavy, or rough objects across the surface can cause scratches or scuffs.

FINISH MATTERS:

Scratches are more visible on certain types of Corian finishes. Dark glossy colours show scratches and wear more easily. Lighter, textured or matte colours are more forgiving and better at concealing minor scratches and scuffs.

RENEWABLE:

The good news is that Corian is renewable! Corian's colour runs all the way through the material, making it entirely renewable. This is a significant advantage as it means that most scratches, scuffs, and even more significant damage can be sanded or polished out.

CARE TIPS

- Never cut or chop on Corian, use a chopping board instead. Cutting directly on Corian will score the work surface!
- Never put hot pans, particularly cast iron, directly on a Corian top or in a sink as such heat can damage any surface.

Like any surface Corian will develop slight abrasion marks in normal daily use but following these care tips will help to protect it.
